Recruitment and Supplier Registration Fraud Warning

The public is informed that Morupule Coal Mine (MCM) does not have any third party agents for recruitment and or supplier registration.

It has come to our attention that some individuals have contacted people falsely pretending to recruit or register on behalf of the mine. In other instances, the perpetrators claim to be MCM agents for the supply of coal.

MCM takes great pride in its ethical and fair employment and procurement practices. MCM has no deal or agreement with any agent for the supply of coal. All customers can buy coal from MCM directly.

We have taken this matter extremely serious, and we are in contact with the appropriate legal authorities to help us stop these fraudulent schemes.

Please note that MCM (nor any of the organizations that may recruit on its behalf) never solicit for any form of payment from applicants at any point in the recruitment or registration process. Furthermore, all individuals who are successful in gaining an offer of employment from MCM, whether directly or indirectly are always required to go through a formal recruitment process.

We strongly recommend that you do not respond to unsolicited business propositions and/or offers from people or companies with whom you are unfamiliar. Do not disclose your personal or financial details to anyone you do not know. If you receive such proposals, we advise you to forward it to MCM's attention at enquiries@mcm.co.bw or contact your local Police Station and provide them with all information you may have received from the impostor (e-mail addresses, phone/fax details, etc.). Always save messages from the perpetrator for further investigation if necessary.
