The Box-cut is 40 meters deep now and No. 2 Seam coal has been intercepted. This weathered coal will be used to dress the ROM pad as well as the slew conveyor discharge area, in preparation to receive the main coal. Mining of overburden will continue as more waste have to be moved to expose the main coal.
