Site Visit

A compulsory site visit for **Maintenance of Perimeter Fencing at Mine Village - (MOR/28/23/03-05)** will be held on 10th May 2023 at 8:30am. It is a pre-requisite that bidders attend a site visit in order to familiarize themselves with the site, the scope of the services and the environmental conditions under which the services are to be performed. Companies attending the site visit are required to register in advance by close of business on 09th May 2023 by sending names of **one (1) representative** per company for the site visit to kmongale@mcm.co.bw. They are also required to arrange their own transport, accommodation and protective clothing, i.e. hard hat, steel toed boots, long sleeved shirt and reflective vest and goggles.

Tenderers are required to submit their tenders to the email address provided in the tender documents on or before **19th May 2023 at 12:00 noon.**

Submissions should be labelled "**MORUPULE COAL MINE – NAME OF TENDER AND REFERENCE NO**" e.g., **for item No.1 above "MAINTENANCE OF PERIMETER FENCING AT MINE VILLAGE - (MOR/28/23/03-05)** - Documents must be submitted in a compressed file/folder format to reduce the size of the documents. Each returnable document must be individually labelled for indexing purposes. The maximum allowable email size at a time shall be 10 MB. Those who wish to submit documents with more than the stated email size will be free to split the submission in multiple parts but not exceeding the reasonable length required. All documents must be in PDF format and the zipped file password protected.
